

DEAR NEIGHBOR

One of the most wondrous things about living in Mineral County is the impressive night sky, and we are working on obtaining an accreditation from International Dark Sky Association. We love the dark! Please help us preserve our night sights by helping in the following ways:

- Turn lights off after 10pm, or better yet, install a timer.
- Only turn lights on when needed - use motion sensors to save power and for safety.
- If leaving for an extended period of time (such as all winter), turn off outdoor lights, even motion sensor lights
- Select less bright bulbs, in warmer/yellow light (≤ 3000 Kelvins).
- Direct and shield lighting to illuminate the ground rather than the sky.
- Kindly share information with neighbors and friends, including referring them to HWA for help in swapping out difficult-to-reach-bulbs. Learn more on our website at headwatersalliance.org
